INTRODUCTION

This report covers the academic year September 2019 - August 2020.

ABOUT THE THAMES VALLEY LEARNING PARTNERSHIP (TVLP)

The Thames Valley Learning Partnership (TVLP) is an equal partnership of state and independent secondary-aged schools in Berkshire.

Our aims include:

- Providing collaborative and informative experiences for secondary-aged students across a range of subjects, thereby providing a variety of learning opportunities and diversity in social and cultural engagement.
- Ensuring that staff across our schools are able to share their passion for their specialist subjects and good practice with one another, and exchange views about current educational issues.

OUR HISTORY

The TVLP appointed a part-time Coordinator, Clare Matheson, in September 2019 to launch the TVLP and to create, develop and deliver a programme of events, networks, competitions and actions that would benefit students and staff at the schools in the partnership.

TVLP CHAMPIONS

Each school has appointed a member of staff to act as a TVLP Champion, regularly liaising with the TVLP Coordinator, and helping to arrange and promote TVLP events, competitions and networks within their school. They are: Mike Gaffin (Beechwood School), Tom Arbuthnott (Eton College), Samantha Smith (Holyport College), Ashley Johnson, (The Langley Academy), Deborah Lombard, (Slough & Eton C of E Business & Enterprise College), Rhian Morgans (St Joseph's Catholic High School), Andrew Smith (St Mary's School Ascot), & Elise Martin (The Windsor Boys' School).

OUR FOUNDING SCHOOLS

The 8 schools that created the TVLP are:

Beechwood School, Eton College, Holyport College, The Langley Academy, Slough & Eton C of E Business & Enterprise College, St Joseph's Catholic High School, St Mary's School Ascot, The Windsor Boys' School.



All our schools are currently located in either the Royal Borough of Windsor & Maidenhead, or in the Borough of Slough.

NEW PARTNERS

Applications from schools wishing to join the TVLP are considered by the TVLP Head Teachers towards the end of each academic year.

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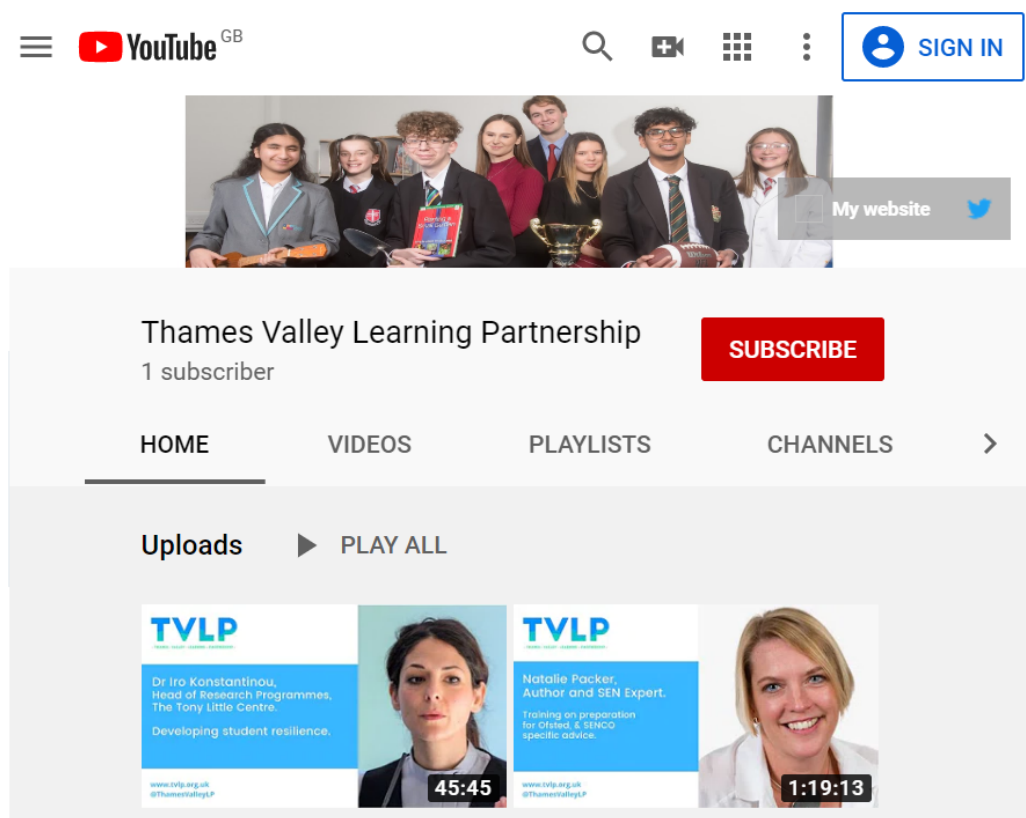
COVID-19 OVERVIEW

The spread of Covid-19 started to affect the UK in February 2020. By mid-March the government had advised self-isolation for anyone showing symptoms of infection. It also advised against large group gatherings. On 23rd March, the government announced a full scale lockdown, including the closure of schools.

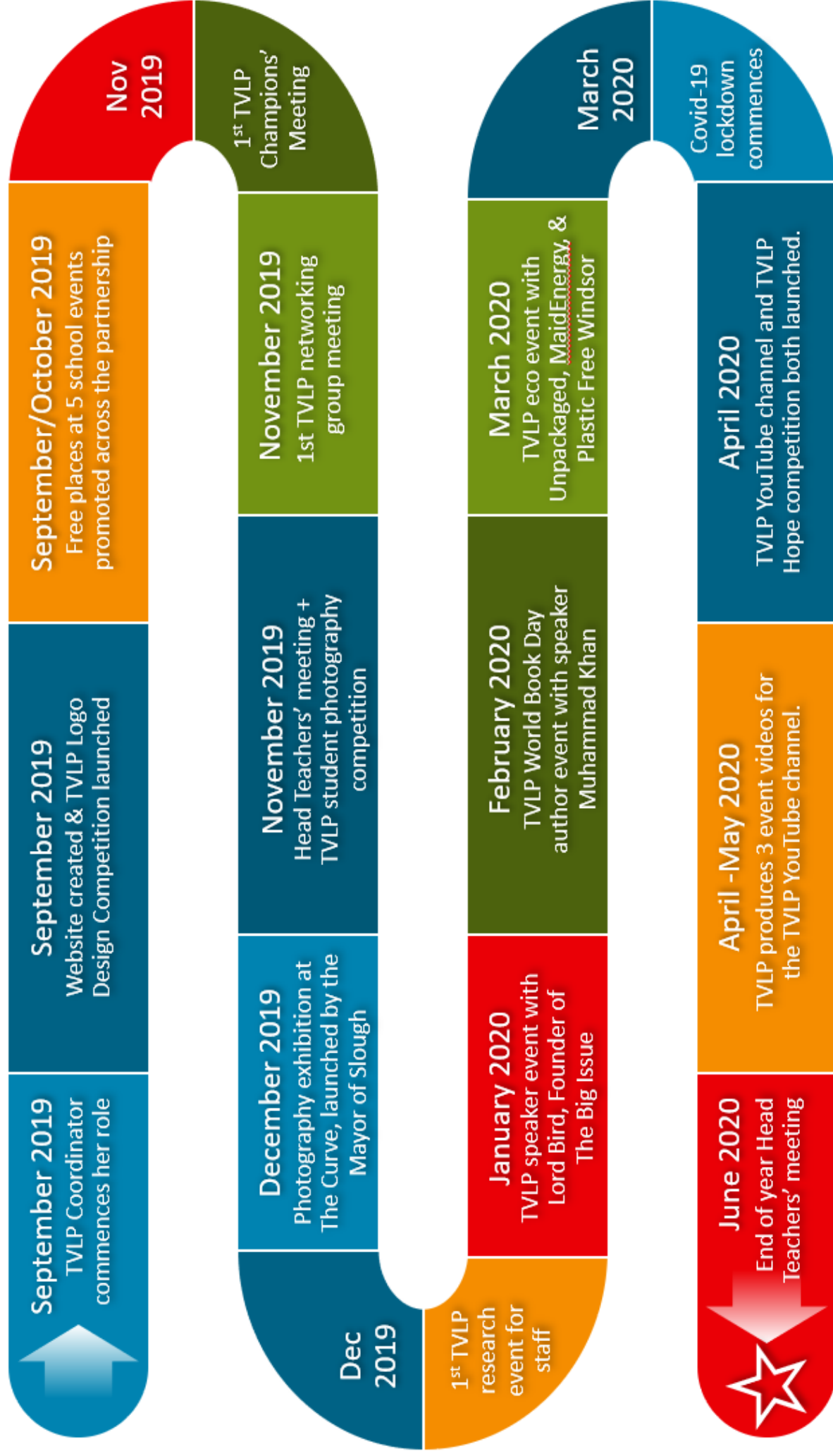
A number of TVLP events were affected as a result. This included the TVLP Orwell Youth Prize Workshop, which had been due to take place at St Mary's School Ascot, the TVLP staff research network event on Rosenshine's Principles at St Joseph's Catholic High School, and the Water Sports Festival at Dorney Lake.

The TVLP Coordinator, Clare Matheson, responded in a number of ways, by:

- Liaising with the relevant schools and event delivery partners, and rearranging events to take place remotely, where possible.
- Creating a new TVLP YouTube channel, and a TVLP ident for the front of YouTube films.
- Recording events online and making these available to TVLP staff and students via YouTube.
- Creating a TVLP Zoom account for online meetings.
- Creating a Coronavirus edition of the TVLP newsletter in March, giving a list of free online learning resources, and details of mental health charities and organisations.
- Sending out event resources, including the Orwell Youth Prize Workshop voiceover Powerpoint slides.
- Liaising with Coordinators of other ISSP's across the country, to share information and ideas.
- Introducing new, reactive activities including the successful Hope poem/short story/poster competition.





MUHAMMAD KHAN

Winner of the 2019 Branford Boase Award, shortlisted for the YA book prize and nominated for the CILIP Carnegie Medal, Muhammad Khan's debut novel, *I Am Thunder*, has received great critical acclaim and he has firmly established himself as a fresh and promising voice in YA literature. When writing *I Am Thunder*, Muhammad sought inspiration from his students at a secondary school where he taught as a maths teacher, as well as from his own upbringing as a British-born Pakistani. *Kick the Moon* was Muhammad's second novel that explores social issues on toxic masculinity and peer pressure. Muhammad holds an engineering degree and MA degree in Creative Writing from St Mary's. He currently resides in South London.

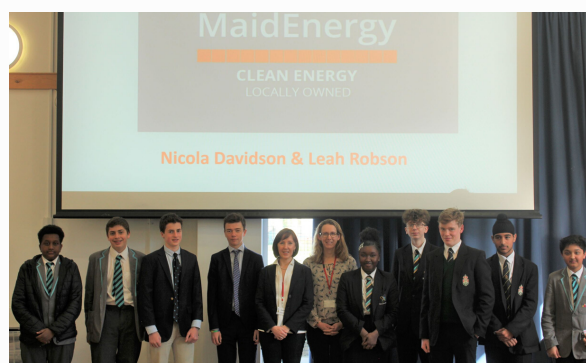

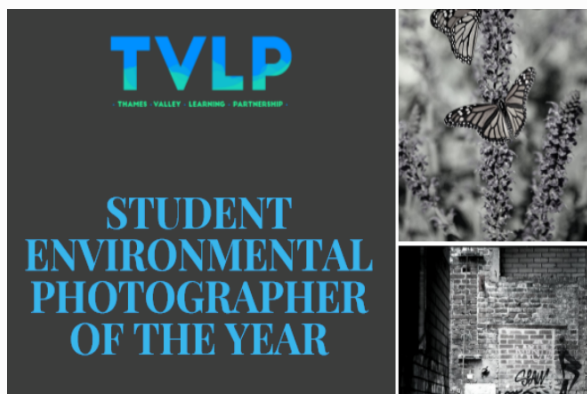
